

## How to say Ameen in our Salah

Now we will learn how to say Ameen in our Salah? There are many different opinions on how to do this. We will concentrate on how holy prophet pbuh said it and just follow that.

We will just ignore and filter out all other opinions in regards to saying Ameen after Surah Fatiha in Salah. Our intention should be that our every deed is of highest status. When we find out authentic Ahadith then our action must follow them. If we are doing anything which is not proven by authentic Ahadith then we should change our actions there and then.

When we read Salah at home then we say Ameen quietly all the times, also when we read sirri Salah ( sirri Salah is in which recitation is done quietly , Zohar, Asar) behind an Imam.

When we read our Salah behind an imam the other Salah's (Fajar, Maghrib, Isha) then we say Ameen louder.

Wa'il bin Hujr narrated: "I heard the Prophet recite: (Not (the way) of those who earned Your anger, nor those who went astray) and he said: 'Amin.' And he stretched it out with his voice." Jami` at-Tirmidhi 248

Narrated Abu Huraira: Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said, "Say Amen when the Imam says 'Ghairi l-maghdubi `alaihim wala d-daalleen' (not the path of those who earn Your Anger (such as Jews) nor of those who go astray (such as Christians)); all the past sins of the person whose saying (of Amin) coincides with that of the angels, will be forgiven". Sahih al-Bukhari 782

See such a huge reward for small deed. Subhan Allah  
Our all sins will be forgiven if our Ameen is same time as one of the angels in heaven.

It was narrated that Abu Hurairah said: "The people stopped saying Amin, but when the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said 'Not (the way) of those who earned Your Anger, nor of those who went astray'[1:7] he would say Amin, until the people in the first row could hear it, and the mosque would shake with it. Ibn e Majah : Vol. 1, Book 5, Hadith 853

Akrama Ra said that I had seen that when Imam said ;

{ غَيْرِ الْمَغْضُوبِ عَلَيْهِمْ وَلَا الضَّالِّينَ } then mosque was echoed with the loud voices of Ameen. (Abi sheeba 186/2)

There are many more Ahadith regarding this.

It was narrated from Ibn ‘Abbas that the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said:  
“The Jews do not envy you for anything more than they envy you for the Salam and (saying) Amin, so say Amin a great deal.”  
Ibn e Majah Vol. 1, Book 5, Hadith 857

We understood from these ahadith that after takbeer e oula, praise of allah, , surah Fatiha, we should recite Ameen and then any part of Quran which we have memorised.

We will continue to say Ameen quietly if we are reading Salah individually or at home.

If we are reading Salah behind an imam then we will say Ameen quietly after Zohar & Asar Salah.

If we are reading Salah behind an imam then we will say Ameen with a loud voice. (For Fajar, Maghrib & Isha prayers after Surah Fatiha)
