



Ablution Part 2

1: One can Read more than one Salah with same ablution

Suleiman bin Buraidah narrated that his father said:

"The Prophet would perform Wudu for every Salah. So during the year of the Conquest, he performed all of the prayers with one Wudu, and he wiped over his Khuff (socks). So Umar RA said, 'You did something that you have not done before?' He replied: "I did it on purpose." (So that people know /learn)

Jami` at-Tirmidhi 61

- We learn from this hadith that we can pray more than one Salah with same ablution and do Masah/wipe on top of our socks.

2: Masah /Wipe over socks

Narrated Mughira bin Shu'ba (rad):

Once I was in the company of the Prophet (ﷺ), he then performed ablution and I dashed to take off his socks. He said, "Leave them for I had put them on after performing ablution". So he wiped over them [Agreed Upon].

Bukhari 206 & Muslim 274

It was narrated that Shuraih bin Hani' said:

"I asked 'Aishah about wiping over the Khuffs and she said: 'Go to 'Ali, for he knows more about that than I do.' So I went to 'Ali and asked him about wiping (over the Khuffs) and he said: 'The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to tell us to wipe (over the Khuffs) for one day and one night for the resident, and three for the traveller.'"

Nisai Vol. 1, Book 1, Hadith 129

- Khuffs: socks

It was narrated that Zirr said:

"I asked Safwan bin 'Assal about wiping over the Khuffs, and he said: 'The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to tell us, when we were travelling, to wipe over our Khuffs (socks) and not take them off for three nights in the event of defecating, urinating or sleeping; only in the case of Janabah (condition after having sexual intercourse).'"

Nisai Vol. 1, Book 1, Hadith 127

- If we are at home then we could do Masah for one day. (Wiping over socks with wet hands). You can read one day's prayers with Masah on socks.
- If you are travelling then you can wipe over socks for three days.

You should do ablution and then put socks on, from then even if your ablutions breaks and you do fresh ablution then you don't need to take socks off, you can just do wipe over them.

If you take your socks off and ablution breaks then you need to wash feet also.

3: Things That Break (Nullify) Ablution (Wuzu)

We should learn these things because it's very important for us.

We should know that what breaks ablution.

ابن عمر، قَالَ قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ. "لَا يَقْبَلُ اللَّهُ صَلَاةً إِلَّا بِطُهُورٍ

It was narrated that Ibn 'Umar RA said:

"The Messenger of Allah said: 'Allah does not accept any prayer without purification.'"

Sahih Muslim 224a

It was narrated that Abu Hurairah RA said:

"The Messenger of Allah said: if a person breaks his ablution, until he does fresh ablution, Allah does not accept his Salah."

Bukhari 225

4: Do ablution after prostatic discharge

Narrated 'Ali bin Abi Talib (rad):

I was one who Madhi (urethral discharge) flowed readily and asked Miqdad (his slave) to ask the Prophet (ﷺ) about it. He (the Prophet) said: 'If you see Madhi (prostatic fluid) then wash your private part and perform Wudu'." Bukhari 132

5: You need to do ablution if you touch your private part

"The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: 'Whoever touches his private part let him perform Wudu'." Tirmidhi 82

6: You need to do ablution if you fell asleep

Ali RA narrated that The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: your both eyes are like laces for your backside, so if you fell asleep then you should do ablution" Abu Dawood 203

Abu Hurairah RA said: ablution is compulsory if someone fell asleep (sleep breaks ablution).

Deep sleep that makes a person completely unaware of his surroundings breaks ablution

This is implied by the Hadith of Anas who said, "The Companions of the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) were waiting for the late night Prayer until their heads began nodding up and down (from drowsiness and sleep). They would then pray without performing ablution." (Muslim, Abu Dawud and At-Tirmidhi).

7: When any of you breaks wind that person should perform ablution

Abu Hurairah RA reported that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said "If one of you finds a disturbance in his abdomen and is not certain if he has released any gas or not, he should not leave the Prayer unless he hears its sound or smells its scent." (Reported by Muslim)

Hearing the escaping gas or smelling it is not a condition for nullifying ablution, but the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) stressed that one should be certain of the action. Abu Dawood 198

8: Bleeding, nose bleed, & vomiting does not break Ablution (wudu)

Bleeding

This involves bleeding due to a wound, cupping or a nosebleed, and regardless of the quantity of blood.

Al-Hassan says, "The Muslims used to pray even while wounded." (Reported by Al-Bukhari) He also reported, "Ibn `Umar squeezed a pimple until it bled, but he did not renew his ablution. Ibn Abi `Uqiyy spat blood and continued his Prayer. `Umar ibn Al-Khattab prayed while blood was flowing from him. `Ibbad ibn Bishr was hit with an arrow while praying, but continued his Prayers." (Reported by Abu Dawud, Ibn Khuzaimah, and Al-Bukhari.)

Vomit

Regardless of whether the amount of vomit is great or small, there is no authentic Hadith stating that it nullifies ablution.

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said "If any of you break ablution during Salah, then you should put your hand on your nose, get out of Salah, do ablution and then return to Salah." Abu Dawood 114

So today we learnt in the light of Ahadith Acts that nullify ablution

- Prostatic discharge breaks ablution
- Touching private parts breaks ablution
- Deep sleep breaks ablution
- Breaking wind/ passing gas break ablution

We must look after our Salah

- We should wear clean clothes for Salah. We should cover our body properly.
- There is no difference between men and women's Salah accept satar (wearing proper garments and covering properly for Salah)
- We should Pin up hijab and have our scarf/shawl wear it properly s it does not move or come off.

- We **must not** touch our hair, nose, scarf or clothes during Salah
- Don't look here and there or touch anything during Salah

- If we have made any mistakes in past ask Allah for his mercy & forgiveness
- Improve our ablution and Salah
